Data Source and Definitions

The Dubuque MSA includes all of Dubuque County, IA

EMSI occupation employment data are based on final EMSI industry data and final EMSI staffing patterns. Wage estimates are based on Occupational Employment Statistics (QCEW and Non-QCEW Employees classes of worker) and the American Community Survey (Self-Employed and Extended Proprietors). Occupational wage estimates also affected by county-level EMSI earnings by industry. This report uses data from the following agencies: Iowa Workforce Development.

Earnings include wages, salaries, overtime, and bonuses.

What are Percentile Wages?

A percentile wage shows the percentage of workers in an occupation that earn less than a given wage and the percentage that earn more.

Northeast Iowa Community College partnered with Greater Dubuque Development Corporation on the implementation of EMSI Analyst and the development of this 2017 Wage & Earnings Survey. This report utilizes EMSI's 2017 2nd quarter data release.
